Definitions:

Observe means that a student is present during a patient encounter or procedure but does not directly participate in the encounter or procedure. Typically, this involves physical presence, but in a telemedicine case, the student could be present digitally. The student is able to visualize what is occurring.

Participate means that the student is actively engaged in the patient encounter or procedure in an assisting role – for example, they are participating directly in a delivery or a surgery as part of the team, while others are performing key parts of the procedure. Students may participate as a member of the team in the care of a patient.

Perform means that the student is directly carrying out the patient encounter or procedure with appropriate supervision. Although they may be observed and given feedback during the patient encounter or procedure, they are completing the task.

Simulated encounter refers to patient encounters or procedures that may be completed in the simulation center.
